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Yard of the Month Guidelines

Each month (except January and February), Wood River recognizes one outstanding property as our Yard of the Month. Winners are chosen by a selection team based on overall appearance, creativity, and adherence to the following guidelines:

Eligibility & Timing

- Awards are not given to rental properties.
- No awards are presented in January or February.
- During periods of extreme drought or poor weather, some months may also be

skipped.

Selection Criteria

- Homeowner design and maintenance are preferred over professional or commercial care.
- The number of previous awards and date of last award are taken into consideration.
- Seasonal decorations may enhance a yard's appeal, but excessive blow-up decorations are discouraged.
- Colorful plantings are highly valued, while artifi-

- cial flowers are not considered.
- Lawns should be neat and tidy, with no visible tools, supplies, or clutter and in compliance.
- HOA dues must be current to be eligible.

Holiday Months

When a major holiday falls within the judging period, seasonal decorations are also considered. However, the landscaping itself should still meet the standards above so that the yard remains attractive once decorations are removed.

Safety Reminder from Corpus Christi PD

The Corpus Christi Police Department recently shared an important reminder for residents regarding the safe operation of off-highway vehicles, golf carts, and electric scooters within masterplanned communities. These rules are designed to keep our neighborhood safe for everyone.

Off-Highway Vehicles and Golf Carts:

- Must be registered with Nueces County.
- A license plate must be affixed to the rear of the vehicle.

- Operators must hold a valid driver's license.
- Vehicles are not allowed on roads posted over 35 mph and must obey all traffic laws.

Electric Scooters:

- Children should always wear helmets.
- Riders must obey all traffic laws and roadway rules.
- Stay as far to the right as possible or use the sidewalk when available.

Following these guidelines helps ensure the safety of all residents, especially children, and protects the community from accidents.

We appreciate your cooperation in keeping our neighborhood safe and enjoyable for everyone.
