

# Brush and Bulky Guidelines

Brush is collected at your residence four times annually. Set out your brush for collection **ONLY** during authorized collection periods. See schedule on pages 17 and 18. Place your 2022 Brush and Bulky collection schedule on your refrigerator to stay up to date all year long.



## Brush Set-Out Guidelines

Brush set-out for collection must only contain shrubs, limbs, grass clippings, weeds, leaves, mulch, and tree trimmings to ensure clean mulch can be produced. Please remember lumber is not considered brush.

Customers are limited to one truckload of materials during each scheduled brush collection period. There is a fee for each additional truckload collected.

Brush may not be placed in the street, gutter, sidewalk, or a drainage ditch. Improper set-out could result in a fee.

Do not pile brush near cars, gas meters, water meters, mailboxes, under low-hanging branches, beneath wires, against fences or by utility poles.

Brush is collected at the same general location as garbage.

Brush may be set-out for collection only during authorized periods. Brush will be collected the week following the set-out dates indicated for your area.

Residents may request an unscheduled collection for a fee. Contact the City's Call Center for rates by dialing 311 or 361-826-CITY (2489).

Small Yard Waste may be placed in your Green/Brown trash cart throughout the year.



**Bobby Bottle** is always welcome in your recycling cart. Caps belong in garbage.

# Brush and Bulky Guidelines

Bulky items are collected along with brush, twice per year. Place your items curbside for collection during authorized bulky items set-out periods only. See schedule on pages 17 and 18.

**Household trash and lumber may NOT be set out for collection.**

## Items For Bulky Collection

- Indoor/outdoor furniture
  - Mattresses
  - Box Springs
  - Carpet
  - Metal or plastic swing sets
  - Plastic swimming pools
  - Large toys
  - Bicycles
  - Aquariums
  - Large household appliances
  - Up to 4 tires, 20 inches in diameter or smaller
- \*Additional tires are subject to a fee*



## Guidelines

Separate bulky items into individual piles by group: metal, non-metal, and brush. Chemicals and concrete are not accepted and should not be placed with bulky materials.

Customers are limited to one truckload of materials during a regularly scheduled brush and bulky collection period. Outside of the collection period, you may contact the City's Call Center by dialing 311 or 361-826-CITY (2489) to request a special collection.
